INSTRUCTIONS: For the purposes of this application, an individual is one person or owner – as in a sole proprietor (not a partner, corporation, or cooperative). Motor vehicle means a passenger car or light truck. Passenger car means a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle, golf cart, light truck, or bus, designed or used primarily for the transportation of persons. Light truck means a commercial motor vehicle that has a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity of one ton or less. Retroactive to January 1, 2007, an individual is entitled to an exemption from taxation of one motor vehicle they own and use in the course of their occupation or profession and also use for personal activities that do not include the production of income. This exemption does not apply to a motor vehicle used to transport passengers for hire (such as, but not limited to, a taxi, bus, or limousine). Attach a copy of the current registration renewal receipt to this application – failure to do so may result in the modification, delay, or denial of the exemption. File this form no later than April 1, 2008. A person who has been granted or applied for this exemption for 2007 may not apply for this exemption again until after the application or exemption has been denied for 2007. It may take several weeks for the appraisal district and tax office to update their records if the exemption is granted. The chief appraiser may require additional information from you, which must be provided within 30 days of the request, or you will forfeit the right to receive the exemption for 2007. If the exemption is modified or denied, the chief appraiser must notify you by certified mail and explain the procedures for protesting this action.
